Mission: Organize, man, train, equip and sustain Navy Expeditionary Logistics Support Group forces to execute cargo handling and other combat service support missions across the full spectrum of naval, joint and combined operations which enable access from the sea and freedom of action throughout the sea-to-shore and inland operating environments.

Vision: NAVELSG is a vital enabler of Maritime Prepositioning Forces (MPF), Joint Logistics Over the Shore (JLOTS) operations, and maritime forces ashore; providing expeditionary cargo handling services for surface, air, and terminal operations, tactical fueling, and ordnance handling/reporting in support of worldwide Naval, Joint, interagency, and combined forces whenever called upon.
